### A WORD FROM PASTOR AMY



During our season of Lent, we have been listening to stories of witness. On Sundays, we've been connecting Old Testament with Gospel readings, hearing how people in biblical times witnessed to God's activity in their lives. On Wednesdays, we've heard personal stories from some of our people on why Jesus matters to them and what has drawn and kept them in the Christian faith. At Tuesday morning Bible study, we've read from voices throughout Christian history to learn of their witness and experience of faith. What's your story? What's our story together as Bethlehem? What is our witness? And how do we share that witness in a world that resists listening to it?

Easter Sunday lands on March 31st this year. As we'll hear in our readings for that special day, Mary Magdalene was the first witness of the resurrection. She declared to the others, "I have seen the Lord!" She had to tell the others! How could she ever hold back such amazing news? How could she not share the Good News of Jesus Christ? At the core of our faith, we believe this is GOOD news for ALL people, and yet we live in a world of many beliefs and many faiths and certainly no faith that complicates sharing this amazing story. It is vital we show respect and dignity to all people of every faith and background, especially in a world that uses violence in response to difference. AND, at the same time, it is critical for us to share from our own faith tradition, from our own beliefs, from our own experiences of God in Christ Jesus. We can do this without being weird. We can do this without shoving our religion down people's throats. We can do this in a way that shares goodness and hope and love. We can do this respectfully and joyfully while honoring the story of others. We just need to learn how.

Most of the time it begins by listening. Truly listening. Not with any agenda or opinions. Just listening and caring and enjoying people. As we listen, notice where God is already working in a person's life. Just like in the stories we heard on Wednesday evenings, we ask ourselves, "Where do I see God in their story?" In other words, where did you see love, a gentle leading, the support of others, goodness, provision, a helping hand, healing, hope? We might offer then, that in our faith tradition we would call that God working in your life. We would name that Jesus. Maybe start with your own life and consider all the ways God has worked in you and for you over your lifetime. Open your eyes and see Jesus.

Then like Mary, we can proclaim, "I have seen the Lord!"




